THE CITY

Cathedral City, commonly known as "Cat City," is named for Cathedral Canyon, which lies to the south. Colonel Henry Washington, a surveyor with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, gave the canyon its name in 1850 because of the cathedral-shaped rock formations he found there.

Like other areas in the Coachella Valley, Cathedral City can be described as mostly suburban. The city itself has grown up around a subdivision that was built in 1925. It has the second-highest population of the nine cities of the Coachella Valley, but it has the second smallest total land area at 21.756 square miles. 28% of this land consists of one-mile parcels of land dedicated to the Agua Caliente Indian Reservation, which also includes a large area of Palm Springs. Cathedral City's population is thusly guite diverse, with a mix of white, African-American, Latino, Asian, Native American, and Pacific Islander citizens. A large LGBT community is also present in Cathedral City, with approximately 25% of the total population of Coachella Valley identifying as gay.

Passport/Visa



Citizens of the Schengen countries, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Japan, South Korea,

Taiwan and the Kingdom of Brunei can visit the United States for up to 90 days without applying for a visa (as well as citizens of Andorra, Lichtenstein, Monaco and San Marino). Citizens of these countries must obtain an ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) before traveling. All other travelers must obtain

a visa before visiting the United States. International travelers need a passport that is valid for at least 3 months after the end of their intended trip in order to enter the country.
