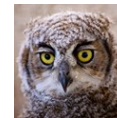

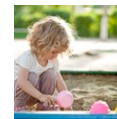

THE CITY

With intentions of “preserving the spirit of the desert,” Cave Creek, Arizona maintains its rugged personality in the form of boundless ranches and historical relevance. Prior to its establishment, Cave Creek was home to the Hopi Nation; much of their imprints have remained in the form of artifacts, drawings and adobes. Following Native presence, Americans moved to the area for gold mining, and the U.S. Cavalry even used it as a rendezvous in the 1870s. Impressively, Cave Creek locals have kept the township relatively the same in the face of changes nearby in Phoenix and Scottsdale.

Cave Creek sits high above Phoenix and Scottsdale in the Black Mountain, Skull Mesa and Elephant Butte foothills. Such a terraced appearance has made it a popular vacation destination, as well as highly recognizable as an “Old Western” town. There are saloons, rodeos, rustic art galleries and Western-style shops. Live music is featured nightly at most venues, bringing in both national and local talents. Play championship golf at world-class courses before browsing through the plentiful specialty stores. And if you find yourself craving that hustle and bustle of the city, Phoenix and Scottsdale are merely a stone’s throw away.

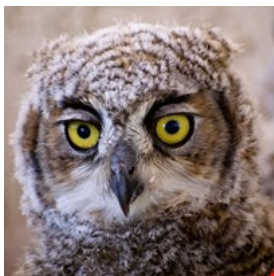

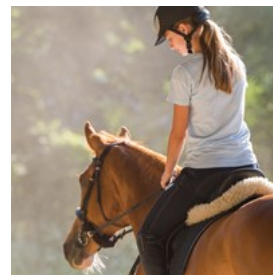

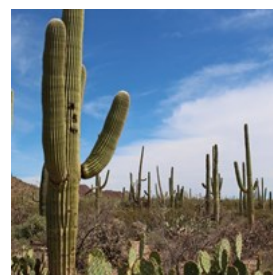

Spur Cross Ranch Conservation

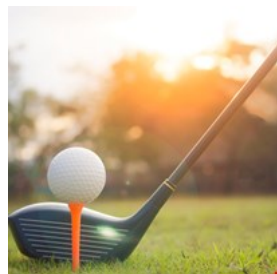


The Spur Cross Ranch Conservation Area is a welcome addition to Cave Creek's rich natural landscaping and history. Spanning 2,154 acres are

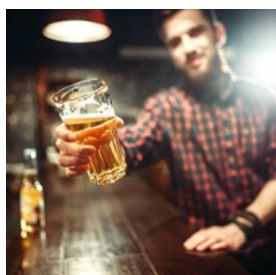


As the oldest restaurant in Cave Creek, The Horny Toad has incurred much regional acclaim. The food is a favorite for dishes like the BBQ

Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport



Cave Creek is served by the nearest airport, Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport. The airport is a hub for US Airways. All major U.S.

airlines, plus Air Canada, British Airways, WestJet and Aeromexico also operate out of PSHIA. Nonstop service is available to roughly 80 domestic and 20 international destinations. The airport is 3 miles (4.8 km) from the central business district with the Valley Metro bus route 13 serving all terminals. Taxi access is through terminals 2, 3 and 4. SuperShuttle provides collective transportation. The Rental Car Center is located in its own building at 1805 East Sky Harbor Circle South.

Passport/Visa



Citizens of the Schengen countries, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Japan, South Korea,

Taiwan and the Kingdom of Brunei can visit the United States for up to 90 days without applying for a visa (as well as citizens of Andorra, Lichtenstein, Monaco and San Marino). Citizens of these countries must obtain an ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) before traveling. All other travelers must obtain a visa before visiting the United States. International travelers need a passport that is valid for at least 3 months after the end of their intended trip in order to enter the country.

The main company for the public transportation in the Phoenix area is Valley Metro. It provides a variety of light rail, bus and local shuttle services to the Phoenix metro area.

The bus service covers a very large area, running on many major roads. The main journeys run daily every 30 minutes, except during the weekend, when they run every hour.

Valley Metro Rail is the public urban rail system that serves downtown and central Phoenix. This service operates every day from 05.00 to about 04.00 the next morning.
