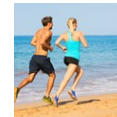

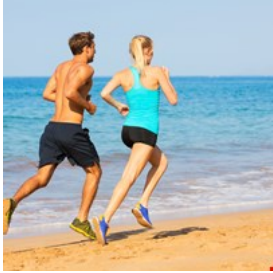

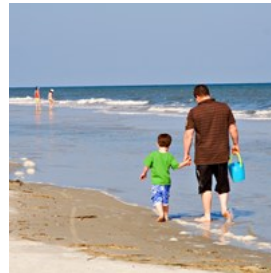

Sea Pines Forest Preserve

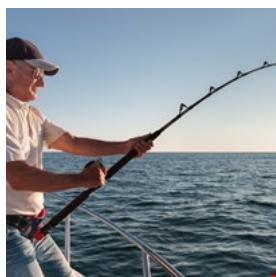


If you are looking for a scenic spot to enjoy the day, drive over to the Sea Pines Forest Preserve. They offer beautiful biking and horseback
